





## 3. Wiring & Installation


- 1. Connect Room station cables as appeared in the figure.(polarity with care)
- 2. Connect Door Release cable as appeared in the figure. (applied only for DR-2GR)
- 3. Check to see whether the system functions.









4. If there is no hole on the wall, you can allocate the wire on the groove around the case as appeared in the figure.
